This means that our public services will run between Pickering and Goathland, as well as on the Esk Valley line between Whitby and Grosmont. Services will be extended to Battersby on Sundays only – over the Christmas holidays, in the school half-term holidays in February, as well as in March. Trains will run from Pickering to Goathland on the same dates.

We believe this will add an extra dimension to the railway this winter. So let us take you on a journey of discovery across the Moors. Marvel at our magnificent engines, sit back and relax in our historic carriages and watch the spectacular scenery go by. And remember that our December Santa trains will run between Pickering and Levisham and between Grosmont and Lealholm on the Esk Valley line.
