No Alcohol Permitted

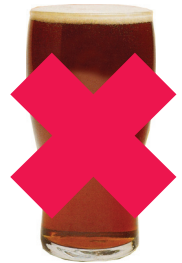
This train is designated as a 'Dry Train'.

This means that all alcoholic drink is banned on board this service.

Passengers will not be allowed to carry any intoxicating liquor in accordance with Railway Byelaw 4 (2).

Please do not try to bring alcohol on board.

British Transport Police will be at stations and will travel on the service to enforce this.



Northern Rail Ltd hereby gives notice that it has prohibited the possession of intoxicating liquor from the following train service each week:

19:15 Whitby to Middlesbrough on Saturday. It is an offence under Byelaw 4 (2) of the Railway Byelaws for any person travelling on this service to be in possession of intoxicating liquor or to attempt to enter any of the above trains with intoxicating liquor.

Everyone should feel comfortable on our services and we work closely with the British Transport Police to make sure that our passengers can travel and our people can work without fear of violence or verbal abuse.

PLEASE REMEMBER

No Alcohol

This is a dry train, which means that all alcoholic drink is banned on board this service: you are not allowed to carry bottles or cans containing alcoholic drink onto the train.
