Tour de Yorkshire 2015

On **Friday 1st May**, Stage 1 of the three day event will be travelling through **Castleton to Whitby** before carrying on to **Robin Hoods Bay** and ending the day at **Scarborough**.



Northern Rail expect the trains and stations to be busy, so please allow extra time for your journey. Wherever possible, extra services and carriages have been added. A detailed **timetable leaflet** has been produced along with posters. You can also view these on the [Tour de Yorkshire page on our website](#).

For one day only, on 1st May, both Northern and North Yorkshire Moors Railway tickets can be used on either company's services specifically between Battersby and Whitby. There will be an NYMR service between Battersby and Whitby, 10.05 from Battersby and 18.00 from Whitby.



The regular times of services will apply for Northern but the units will be **doubled to four carriages**. There will also be an **extra late evening service**: 20.49 (8.49 pm) from Middlesbrough arriving Whitby at 22.20 (10.20 pm) 22.25 (10.25 pm) from Whitby arriving Middlesbrough 23.51 (11.51 pm).

The car park at Whitby will be closed to all traffic for the day. **A large screen televising the event** will be located on 'Dockend' which is the area opposite the station car park overlooking the harbour. Whitby Town Council have organised some **activities on the day in and around the harbour**.

One of the hubs for watching the race on a large screen will be at **Danby Moors Centre**. There will be a host of activities during the day. Also **Glaisdale** and **Castleton** have a programme of events, as well as other villages. You can download the Tour@Glaisdale poster from the [Tour de Yorkshire page on our website](#).

Rolling road closures mean that police will shut roads approximately 40 minutes before the riders pass through and reopen soon afterwards. The estimated closure time is approximately 1 hour. Check the [Welcome to Yorkshire website](#) for more information.
